Dr Wayne Morriss works as an anaesthesiologist in Christchurch, New Zealand. He is a member of the Board and Council of the World Federation of Societies of Anaesthesiologists. He was the Chair of the WFSA Education Committee from 2012-2016 and is currently the Director of Programmes.

He trained in New Zealand and Australia and then worked for two years as a Senior Lecturer at the Fiji School of Medicine in Suva, Fiji. He returned to New Zealand in 2002. Since then, he has remained very active in medical education, with frequent teaching trips to the Pacific region and further afield.
